PeaceWorks Stockholm Annual Report 2024

The year 2024 marked a pivotal phase of strategic development and organizational renewal for PeaceWorks Stockholm. Grounded in our commitment to youth-led engagement, we advanced our mandate as a local chapter of PeaceWorks Sweden through a combination of targeted programming, inter-organisational collaboration, and internal capacity-building.

Our efforts this year focused on inclusive civic engagement, intercultural learning, and anti-racist youth work. Support for initiatives such as the *Colours of Africa Festival* and the planning of the *Iftar/Easter Dinner* reflected our ongoing commitment to operationalising PeaceWorks' values at the local level—particularly in the areas of equity, participatory culture, and cross-community solidarity.

Internally, we prioritized governance refinement, clarified strategic priorities, and strengthened mechanisms for member participation and board accountability. This included active involvement in national-level capacity-building platforms such as the *Antirasistisk Verkstad*.

At the core of our work were vital conversations—on justice, belonging, safety, and structure—that continue to shape how we can build environments that resist racism and centre the empowerment of young people from the ground up.

Together the board organised quarterly meetings focused on strategy, partnerships, social media engagement, and project planning.





Key 2024 Activities

Antirasistisk Verkstad (Anti-Racism Workshop)

In November 2024 (Week 47), PeaceWorks Sweden, the national umbrella under which we operate, invited anti-racist and solidarity-focused associations, networks, and groups to an anti-racism workshop. As PeaceWorks Stockholm, we joined as learners, participants, and collaborators—eager to grow our understanding and strengthen our practice.

The workshop's theme was:

How can we uncover racist disinformation, and how can we create anti-racist and solidarity-driven initiatives and actions, especially those aimed at young people, using PeaceWorks' DRIV method? Amongst other methods

DRIV, developed by PeaceWorks Sweden, is a youth-centred framework that integrates Democracy, Rights, Inclusion, and Nonviolence into community engagement and organisational development.

PeaceWorks Sweden facilitated exercises, reflections, and peer-to-peer dialogues. As participants, we engaged in:

- Theatre of the Oppressed: embodying dialogue and resistance through roleplay, image theatre, and group reflection.
- Scenario-building: reimagining youth spaces free from racism and gatekeeping.
- Pilot ideation groups: prototyping local projects on anti-racist youth outreach and democratic organising.

Colours of Africa Summer Collaboration

PeaceWorks supported the Colours of Africa Festival through:

- Volunteer recruitment and youth engagement.
- Event promotion via social media and networks.
- Coordinating logistics and community connections.
- Providing translation to speakers for accessibility.

Planned Iftar & Easter Dinner (Spring)

Although the 2024 edition of this multicultural celebration was postponed due to time and venue constraints, the planning process laid the necessary groundwork.





Petition Campaign for Global Justice

Inspired by conversations around Colombian peace and international solidarity, PeaceWorks Stockholm began planning a petition campaign. The effort includes:

- Outreach to like-minded NGOs.
- Youth training on political education and advocacy.

Budget Outcomes & Grant Notes - 2024

In 2024, PeaceWorks Stockholm operated using carry-over funds from the previous year. As such, the financial situation remained stable, and planned activities were not negatively affected despite the absence of new projects or organisational grants.

While the 2024 budget initially included a planned *föreningsbidrag* (organisational grant) from PeaceWorks Sweden, the board was unable to submit the application in time due to the annual meeting being held later than usual. Consequently, no new organisational grant was awarded, and no youth project funding was distributed. Nonetheless, the association's operations continued as planned, thanks to unspent funds from 2023.


Total Cost: 3372.06

The primary expenditures were limited to necessary administrative fees—namely, banking costs and communication platform services.

Annual Financial Results – 2024

The financial year 2024 began with an opening balance of **46,261.55 SEK**, carried forward from the previous year.





No new project grants were received during the reporting period. Project-related expenditures and operational costs resulted in a **net deficit of 3,372.06 SEK**. No new assets or liabilities were recorded under project grant allocations.

There were no outstanding liabilities or recorded debts during the year, and no new project grants were received.

As of 31 December 2024, the closing balance stood at **42,889.49 SEK**, which remains available for future project work and administrative needs.

Strategic Vision for 2025

Our foundational approach is rooted in the principle that young people are not beneficiaries of social change—they are its primary drivers. Centering young people in decisions that affect them is essential to how our communities are built, governed, and sustained.
